#### **Junior Dog (8)**

**1** Ryan's Belatarr Sculptor-Robustly built, substantial youngster, strong bone & well balanced overall. Handsome head, developing well with kind expression & ample facial furnishings. Straight front, well laid shoulders, muscular neck, well developed chest with good angulations. Good coat colour & texture. Needs to gain a little more control of his limbs but I am sure this will improve as he matures.

2. Harris' Zoldmali Zeno At Tykashyyk – Another well built youngster with a great frame, level back, firm loin & masculine head. Maturing nicely, but needs to tighten in front.

#### **POST GRAD DOG (7)**

**1.** Godfrey's Tragus Kestrel – Medium sized, compact & balanced with no exaggerations. Good spring of rib & strong loin. Proportionate head. Harsh wire coat with good colour & texture. Neat feet. Moved steadily, keeping his topline.

2. Wild's Herlinga Harlan- Pleasing head with clean neck, straight front, well laid shoulders & moderate rear angulations. Harsh feel to his coat. Moved well with drive.

3. Allison's Napvirag Dolgos Ario

### **OPEN (5)**

1. Godfrey's Tragus Rudo- Very close decision between these two mature boys. Super outline, straight front, muscular neck & well laid shoulders, well sprung rib, strong bone structure. Shown in his best coat with the most appealing handsome head & such a gentle melting expression. Moved well covering the ground with ease.
2. Mcleish's Cwssewn Cadiz – Another sound, well balanced muscular dog with strong bone, robustly built, good front & rear angulations. Clean outline, firm loin & super topline which he retained as he powered around the ring. Felt he could do with a little more weight on the day.
