For dogs and handlers who have not entered more than two KC working tests and have not won a first in Special beginners or an award in any classified class. Training and help will be given.

PUPPY

Judge: Louise Holmes

Confined to dogs / bitches less than 18 months of age on the date of the test.

NOVICE

Judges: Jean Robertson (A Panel), Jayne Herbert, Lee Loveridge (B Panel 3307)

For dogs / bitches which have not gained a Field Trial Award or COM, or 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open GWT or First in a Novice GWT held in accordance with KC Regulations.

OPEN

Judge: Jason Hudson

Open to all HPR Dogs/Bitches

WATER

Judge: Paul MacDonald

We reserve the right to add or alter judges should it prove necessary on the day.

It should be noted that:

1. Dogs must be kept on their leads at all times unless competing.
2. This site is regularly used by children so you must pick up after your dog and remove waste from site.
3. Handlers may enter more than one dog providing that they take responsibility for getting to the tests promptly. At the discretion of the steward these dogs may be moved up the running order but not replace the next two dogs preparing to compete.
4. Entry fees will not be collected in the event of cancellation.
5. Entries will only be accepted from Gundogs registered at the Kennel Club in the Gundog Group.
6. Bitches in season should not be brought to the ground.
7. Excessive disciplining of dogs will result in disqualification.
8. Please bring your own refreshments and water for your dogs as there is no tap on site.

All persons attending do so at their own risk. Neither the HWVA nor the hosts or landowners will accept liability for any accident, illness, loss or injury to dogs, owners, handlers, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

DIRECTIONS –

From the South: Take junction 21a off the M1 take the A46 towards Newark where the A46 meets the A606 turn left towards Nottingham. Take the first turning on the left (Station Rd). Follow Station Rd towards Widmerpool. At T junction turn left. After a sharp right hand bend the road becomes Wysall Rd. Follow Wysall Rd for 1 mile. The venue is on the right

From the North: Take A1 towards Newark. Join the A46 towards Leicester. At the junction with the A606 turn right and follow the directions as above.

OR IF USING SAT NAV. NG12 5PW ignore instruction to turn down church lane but continue straight on and venue is about half a mile on right. There will be sign posts out.
